Advocacy in Action

Have your voice heard. A big part of the work of the CAND is to advocate on behalf of the profession at the federal level. Here's what we have been working on:

TIMES HAVE CHANGED & BENEFITS SHOULD TOO.

The CAND recommends enhancing billing codes to ensure greater clarity and transparency in their descriptions.

AREAS TO INCLUDE IN BILLING CODES:

- initial naturopathic visit
- naturopathic consult (for any subsequent visits)
- in-office naturopathic procedure
- acupuncture
- laboratory testing (if covered)

Naturopathic Doctors are highly educated and complete extensive post-graduate training and clinical hours. NDs are recognized as part of the Canadian Health Workforce Network's Team Primary Care.

NATUROPATHIC DOCTORS: A MOVE TO ACCURATE LANGUAGE & COVERAGE

A simple coverage change from "Naturopath" to "Naturopathic Doctor" provides clarity, and can be validated by the clinician's provincial registration number, their CAND membership or both (a model already used by Veterans Affairs Canada). The time has come to close the loophole and ensure that only qualified Naturopathic Doctors can bill under the extended benefit intended for naturopathic medicine. CAND is ready to help.

Insurance: Working towards changes

In June we attended the CHLIA Claims and Anti-Fraud Conference in Calgary, and shared insights into the expertise and education of NDs. Our messaging focused on asking benefit providers to change coverage language in paramedical benefits to list "Naturopathic Doctors" and not simply use the term "Naturopath". We also asked for




Assembly of First Nations (AFN):

With the dedication and vision of numerous champions, Naturopathic Medicine has become a leading primary health care profession in Canada. This has not happened without struggle.

As naturopathic medicine evolved from its many roots in European, North American, Eastern and Indigenous traditions, the medical profession through the 20th century increasingly focused on 'eradication' of disease through antimicrobial, surgical and technological approaches for assessment and treatment. Healing through prevention, dietary and functional approaches was relegated to a secondary role.

However, science is now confirming the influence of gut health, nutritional and antioxidant status and the negative effects of pollution, stress, dietary and lifestyle factors as significant determinants of health and disease. There is a greater acknowledgement of the synergy between a healthy body and a healthy mind, and naturopathic assessments and care strategies have become more relevant and valued within the public collective consciousness.

It is important to honour our pioneers and advocates for the significant roles and impacts that their contributions and decisions have made for the future of naturopathic medicine. We will begin with Joseph Boucher and Gerald Farnsworth, Canadian ND's whose legacies, beginning in the 1950s, have shaped the naturopathic profession in both the US and Canada.


